Fall Color: Bronze tint in colder months

Buxus sempervirens 'Suffruticosa'

Zone: 5

Height: 30 in

Width: 30 in

Foliage: Green

Fall Color: Evergreen

Disease Resistant to box leaf miner

'Suffruticosa' is a classic, dwarf Boxwood that grows slowly - about 1" per year. Perfect for topiaries and formal hedges.

Foliage: Deep green w/ maroon highlights

Flower: Cherry red

Season: Spring until first frost

Maintenance-free and resistant to black spot & downy mildew leaf disease.

Zone: 5

Height: 3-5 ft

Width: 3-4 ft

Foliage: Dark green, semi-glossy

Flower: Bright yellow fading to a pastel cream color

Season: Spring until first frost

Compact, upright habit and resistant to black spot
